Don Nabity Scholarship

Attention Young Insurance Professionals agency members! You may be eligible to receive scholarship assistance to attend the 2020 Big "I" Legislative Conference May 13-15, 2019 in Washington D.C.

PIIAC's Don Nabity Fund annually sponsors a limited number of full to partial scholarships for members who qualify. Any insurance professional employed by a PIIAC member agency who is age 40 or younger, or who has been in the insurance industry for less than five years is eligible to apply. Applying for a Nabity Scholarship is easy. Simply complete the application form, and submit it to PIIAC along with a short essay on how attendance at this association-sponsored event will contribute to the betterment of your career and help your agency.

The deadline to apply for a scholarship is Wednesday, January 8, 2020. Selection of scholarship recipients is based on eligibility and essay content. Multiple scholarships may be awarded. The Don Nabity Fund is supported by private donations and fund-raising events sponsored by PIIAC's Emerging Leaders Committee.

These events afford excellent opportunities for young professionals to network with and learn from some of the most successful agency personnel from around the country. Programs geared specifically for young professionals and those new to the business are offered throughout the events.

Don Nabity was the Executive Vice President for Independent Insurance Agents of Colorado for many years, and retired as EVP Emeritus around 1981. As EVP, Nabity started one of the first young agents committees in the country. Don Nabity was an outspoken advocate and supporter for young people entering the insurance industry decades ago.

In 1998, then PIIAC president, Joan Haddock of Haddock Insurance announced the Don Nabity Scholarship in his name. Joan and Ray Haddock were instrumental in leading other industry professionals to help fund scholarships from the very beginning. Today scholarships are funded through private donations and special events such as the annual Don Nabity golf tournament.

Scholarship Rules

Scholarship awards are non-transferable and are not redeemable for cash. The total value of a scholarship is up to \$1,500 in eligible reimbursements. Expenses eligible for reimbursement upon receipt of paid receipts are limited exclusively to conference registration for scholarship recipient, lodging for recipient (room and tax) for nights of conference only at the host hotel economy rate and round trip coach, non refundable airfare to the IIABA events only. Scholarship recipients are responsible for all additional costs associated with attending the event for which the scholarship is awarded.

The deadline to apply for a scholarship is Wednesday, January 8, 2020. Selection of scholarship recipients is based on eligibility and essay content. Multiple scholarships may be awarded.
